Uniform Regulations

Tomorrow, the beginners will receive their jackets. In connection with this, we would like to remind everyone of the uniform regulations. The full regulations are attached, and we ask all parents to read them. I have also included an information sheet with some useful tips.

Here is a summary of the regulations that you should review with the band members:

When wearing the uniform, you are representing Klæbu School Band, and we expect good behavior.

A uniform is valuable and should be handled with care. The jacket costs about NOK 5000 and the pants around NOK 1500. The uniform must be kept clean and in good condition while you are borrowing it. The uniform should only be worn during performances.

If the uniform gets dirty, you can wipe it gently with a damp cloth. If this is not enough, the uniform manager will have it cleaned for you.

Loss or damage due to negligence or improper washing of the uniform will be the responsibility of the parents.

You are responsible for purchasing shoes (all-black dress shoes with black soles) and a shirt (plain white dress shirt with white buttons and collar). The band has some used shirts and shoes which you can borrow.

The uniform should be kept in the garment bag when not in use and during transport.
